Abstract and proceedings guidelines

Abstract (and extended abstracts) in Ukrainian, Russian or English as attached file with a last name of the first author should be sent to the Organizing committee. If one author submits more than one abstract, he has to add a digit after his name in the file name. The following text file types are admitted: doc, docx, rtf.

Abstract formatting. The main text length is set up to 2 pages, including references. The page format is A4; all margins are 2 cm. Font: Times New Roman, main text font size is 14 pt; references list font text size is 12 pt, use of styles is not allowed. Interval is 1. Title, authors’ names, their affiliations are centered. Title must be given in bold capital letters; the next line must contain last names and initials of the authors in italics. Author’s affiliation including institution, city, country and email must be presented each in a new line. For multiple institutions the numbered superscripts must be used. Presenting author name is underlined.

The main text with paragraph line indent of 1 cm should be justified on both sides, no word breaks. With exception to simple formulas, all formulas should be typed using Microsoft Equation editor. Embedding of tables and images is not allowed.

References in the main text should be presented in succession in square brackets. The list of references in order of mentioning must be located below the main text with names of authors typed in italics.

Text will be published as in author’s version.

Abstract example is placed below.

Proceedings formatting. General instructions for professional academic publication of Institute may be found at <http://igmof.org.ua/uk/видання/геохімія-та-рудодутворення/>. In addition to these instructions, the total text length should not exceed 15 pages.
